

Installation Instructions for Rotary Stainless Steel Bowl Brackets in Stainless Steel Gates

1. Place a ¹/₄-20 x 1" stainless steel truss head screw through (1) mounting bracket and (1) bronze bearing. Insert the screw assembly through the top of the main bowl insert. Note: the bearing should be a snug fit in the bowl insert. Using a 7/16" wrench and a Philipps screwdriver, install a ¹/₄-20 Nyloc nut onto the screw and tighten. In the same manner install a screw assembly to the bottom of the main bowl insert. See figure 1. Note that the brackets must be oriented as shown below.



2. Place the bowl insert assembly into the gate opening. Align the mounting holes in the brackets with the pre-drilled holes in the gate. After ensuring that the bowl insert is aligned properly in the opening use (4) #14 x 1" TEK screws to secure the mounting brackets to the gate. See figure 2.



3. Install (1) pendant by inserting a 1/4-20 x 1.5" stainless steel screw through the pendant and then into the hole provided in the gate. Place a ¼-20 Stainless steel Nyloc nut on the screw. Using two 7/16" wrenches, tighten the nut until the pendant starts to bind. Back the nut off slightly until the pendant just starts to move freely. See figure 3.


